RESOLUTION NO. 689-2023

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2023 OF STA. MARIA, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P9,834,907.00, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 01 for Calendar Year 2023 involving total appropriations of Php9,834,907.00, which was enacted on June 13, 2023 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 23-01;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That the funding sources for the subject Supplemental Budget were determined in accordance with Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160 and Article 417(a) of its IRR, as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;

- 2. That the utilization of appropriations from FY 2020 shares of the Municipality from Burley and Native Tobacco Excise Tax Collections shall be subject to the provisions of Local Budget Memorandum No. 86 dated December 14, 2022;
- 3. That the items funded out of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund shall be in accordance with R.A. No. 10121 known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 and its IRR, and the DBM-NDRRM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013 - 1 dated March 25, 2013 re: Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and 30% shall be set aside as Quick Response Fund;
- 4. That all programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and the FY 2023 Supplemental Investment Program of the municipality formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007; and
- That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the provisions of R.A. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Noel C. Bince and Salvador S. Perez, Jr. and co-sponsored by SP Members Jerome Vic O. Espino, Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan and Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Operative in its Entirety the Supplemental Budget No. 01 for Calendar Year 2023 of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
