**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 604, S-2023 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SIP) NO. 3, CY 2023 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PANGASINAN"**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingayen, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 604, S-2023 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. The Municipal Development Council of Lingayen, Pangasinan prepared their Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 3 for CY 2023. This is in accordance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991;
2. Said Supplemental Investment Program, which has a total investment requirement of ₱22,078,000.00, covers the augmentation of funds for Personal Services (granting of Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) to municipal officials and employees), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses and Capital Outlay of municipal offices, and the implementation of development projects and Disaster Risk Reduction programs of the LGU;

3. The development projects to be funded from the 20% DF, in the amount of P4,350,000.00, conforms with Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects); and
4. Funding for the Supplemental AIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 03, FY 2023, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 04, S-2023 dated December 4, 2023.

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Lingayen, Pangasinan;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Philip Theodore E. Cruz and Haidee S. Pacheco and co-sponsored by SP Members Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., Joyce D. Fernandez and Maria Doriza V. Ramos, duly seconded, it was—
