PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 1000-2024

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, THROUGH THE PANGASINAN 3RD DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE, TO SET UP APPROPRIATE EARLY WARNING DEVICES OR ROAD SIGNAGES FOR SAFETY AND PREVENTIVE MEASURES ALONG THE AMBASSADOR EDUARDO “DANDING” M. COJUANGCO, JR. AVENUE, ALSO KNOWN AS URDANETA BYPASS ROAD

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 states in its general welfare clause that every local government unit has the sworn obligation to promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, through the Committee on Barangay and Rural Development, Public Order and Safety, conducted a public hearing last October 16, 2024, pertaining to the frequent occurrences of road incidents involving illegal drag racing activities in the Province of Pangasinan, particularly at the 7.17-kilometer Bypass Road located in Urdaneta City;

WHEREAS, during the said hearing, several resource speakers from different government agencies have confirmed the veracity of road incidents that happened at the Urdaneta Bypass Road involving motorists and bystanders alike;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan expresses its utmost concern over the matter as this kind of sports activity poses a serious threat to the interest and welfare of the city and other nearby residents;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan strongly believes that accidents at the Urdaneta Bypass Road could be minimized, if not prevented, when appropriate road safety signages are in place to forewarn motorists as well as the public of road dangers and hazards;

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled to request, as it is hereby requested, the Department of Public Works and Highways, through the Pangasinan 3rd District Engineering Office, to set up appropriate early warning devices or road signages for safety and preventive measures along the Ambassador Eduardo “Danding” M. Cojuangco, Jr. Avenue, also known as Urdaneta Bypass Road;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Department of Public Works and Highways, through the Pangasinan 3rd District Engineering Office, in Tumana, Rosales, Pangasinan, for their information and appropriate action.
