DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 2024-19 OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE PLANTILLA POSITION OF COMPUTER OPERATOR I, SG-7/1 UNDER THE ARCHIVES OFFICE OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN AND CREATING THE FOLLOWING POSITIONS UNDER THE SAME OFFICE, TO WIT: 1) ADMINISTRATIVE AIDE IV (BOOKBINDER II), SG-4/1; 2) ADMINISTRATIVE AIDE III (AUDIO-VISUAL EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I), SG-3/1” AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Alaminos, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 2024-19 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted in accordance with Sections 76 & 458 (a) (1) (viii) of the R.A. 7160;

WHEREAS, it is now imperative on the part of the Local Chief Executive in coordination with the City Local Finance Committee to provide an appropriation and to back up the legal existence of the positions being created.
