**RESOLUTION NO. 324-2024**

**APPROVING MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION NO. 217-2023 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF ANDA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANDA, PANGASINAN FOR CY 2024 AND AUTHORIZED ITS IMPLEMENTATION EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2024”**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Anda, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 217-2023 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. In pursuance to Sections 106, 109, and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Development Council of Anda, Pangasinan has formulated the municipality’s Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2024, which was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval through MDC Resolution No. 03, Series of 2023 dated October 5, 2023;
2. The AIP of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for LGUs, 2023 edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007, DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMD No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Anda, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form categorized into general



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- public, social, economic and other services. It likewise covers: (a) all the regular budgetary items for the operations of the different municipal offices broken down into PS, MOOE and Capital Outlay, (b) the priority development programs/projects and those to be funded by 20% development fund, and (c) disaster risk reduction management programs/projects/activities of the municipality. It further includes the following: 1) Gender and Development Plan, Peace and Order Plan, Local Nutrition Action Plan, Annual Cultural Development Plan, Local Climate Change Action Plan, Local Youth Development Plan, Annual Procurement Plan and; 2) List of programs/projects/activities for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities, List of PPAs to Address the Problems of Illegal Drugs 6) PPAs to combat Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome and PPAs to Address Problems on Illegal Drugs. It is recommended however, that the LGU shall use the new prescribed AIP Summary Form in accordance to Local Budget Memorandum No. 87 dated June 9, 2023 in their next Annual/Supplemental Investment Program preparation;
3. The proposed AIP has a total investment requirement amounting to Php195,785,834.42. The amount of Php188,876,353.31 will be funded from the municipality's proposed 2024 Annual Budget enacted through Appropriation Ordinance No. 03, Series of 2023 on November 28, 2023 and approved by the Municipal Mayor on December 02, 2023. The remaining programs/projects/activities will be funded under Special Trust Fund amounting to Php6,909,481.11;
  4. The development fund amounting to Php32,757,015.20 which is allocated for development projects is equivalent to 20% of the municipality's NTA amounting to Php163,785,076.00 for CY 2024. This is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160;
  5. The identified development programs/projects to be funded by the 20% of NTA are based on the DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and the Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Developments Projects)";
  6. The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Programs/Projects/Activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the municipality amounting to Php10,450,000.00 is integrated in the AIP and conforms with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs, projects and activities to be funded by 70% of the 5% LDRRM Fund in the amount of Php7,315,000.00 are based on NDRRMC-DBM-DILG Joint Memo-Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation
