### RESOLUTION NO. 655-2024

**DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 02, S-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF INFANTA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING CERTAIN PLANTILLA POSITIONS AND CREATING NEW POSITIONS UNDER THE DIFFERENT OFFICES IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF INFANTA, PANGASINAN" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG TO ENACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Infanta, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 02, Series of 2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted in accordance with Sections 76 and 447 (a) (1) (viii) of R. A. No. 7160;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Chief Executive in coordination with the Municipal Local Finance Committee shall prepare a Supplemental appropriation (Supplemental Budget) to implement the subject ordinance and a revised plantilla of personnel of the concerned offices shall be submitted;
