RESOLUTION NO. 28-2025

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 182, S-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF INFANTA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF INFANTA, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Infanta, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 182, S-2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject resolution is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991. The Local Development Council of Infanta, Pangasinan has identified items in their Fourth Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) for CY 2024. This was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan on November 12, 2024 through MDC Resolution No. 10, Series 2024;
2. The SAIP No. 04 with a total investment requirement of PhP23,819,654.65, covers fund augmentation for the Personal Services, Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses, and Capital Outlay of some municipal offices, and implementation of disaster risk reduction and management programs and other priority projects of the LGU; and

3. Funding support for the full implementation of the said SAIP is embodied in the municipality's Supplemental Budget No. 4 CY 2024, amounting to PhP8,996,710.85, which was approved and enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan on November 19, 2024 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 05, Series of 2024. The remaining PhP14,822,943.80 will be funded under the Special Education Fund (PhP2,829,500.00), Konsulta Trust Fund (PhP1,993,443.80), and LGSF-FA to LGUs (PhP10,000,000.00).




