**RESOLUTION NO. 42-2025**

**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 430, S-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025"**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bayambang, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 430, S-2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject Resolution is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991. The Municipal Development Council of Bayambang, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for CY 2025. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan through MDC Resolution No. 7, Series of 2024 dated May 22, 2024;
2. The Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2023 edition, and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-1 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Bayambang was prepared using the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: (a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the

different offices broken down into Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, (b) priority development programs/projects of the LGU, including those funded by the 20% Development Fund, (c) Disaster-Risk Reduction (DRR) programs, projects, and activities, and (d) activities in pursuance of the objectives of Gender and Development (GAD) of the LGU as indicated in the DILG-endorsed GAD Plan and Budget.

Also attached to the AIP are the following: (a) Local Climate Change Action Plan, (b) Peace and Order Plan, (c) Local Youth Development Plan (d) Local Nutrition Plan (e) Annual Cultural Development Plan, (f) Indicative Annual Procurement Plan, (g) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, (h) List of for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability, (i) Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council Plan, (j) List of PPAs to Combat Covid-19 and (K) Municipal Physical Fitness and Sports Development Council Plan of the LGU;

3. The proposed AIP of Bayambang for CY 2025 has a total investment requirement of P5,070,726,937. Of this, the sum of P651,584,937.22 will be financed by the LGU as embodied in their proposed Annual Budget for CY 2025 which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 07, Series of 2024 (for the General Fund) and Appropriation Ordinance No. 08, Series of 2024 (for the Special Economic Enterprise), both dated October 7, 2024. The remaining estimated amount of P4,419,142,000.38 will be derived from external sources;
4. This AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of Local Government Code of 1991. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGU's IRA/NTA (P454,351,626.00 amounting to P90,870, 325.20, is allocated for development projects;
5. The development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% Development Fund were based on the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No.1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects);
6. The attached Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Programs/Projects/Activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the LGU amounting to P29,684,572.05 conform with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs/projects to be funded from the 70% of the LDRRMF, in the amount of P20,779,200.43 are based on the NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk

Reduction and Management Fund) and the 30% amounting to P8,905,371.62, is allocated for Quick Response Fund (QRF).

The LDRRM Fund Investment Plan 2025 of the LGU was reviewed and validated by the Office of Civil Defense Regional Office I through their Local DRRM Plan 2024-2029 as per attached Certification from OCD-RO1;

7. The LGU of Bayambang has also identified programs, projects and activities which are responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 2023, 2015; and
8. The Gender and Development Plan and Budget for CY 2025 of the LGU was reviewed and approved by the DILG Provincial Office, and found out to be compliant in form and content with the provisions of the PCW-DILG-DBM-NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC Nos. 2013-01 and 2016-01 (Guidelines on the Localization of the Magna Carta of Women).

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Bayambang, Pangasinan;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Shiela Marie F. Baniqued and Vici M. Ventanilla and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—


