RESOLUTION NO. 61-2025

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 2024-302 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SISON, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM-CY 2025 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SISON, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sison, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 2024-302 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

- 1. In pursuance to Sections 106, 109, and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Development Council of Sison, Pangasinan has formulated the municipality's Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2025, which was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval through MDC Resolution No. 07-2024, Series of 2024, dated September 19, 2024;
- 3. The Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for LGUs, 2023 edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007, dated March 8, 2007, DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMD No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 and Local Budget Memorandum No. 90 dated June 13, 2024 as to format and content. The AIP of Sison, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form categorized into





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general public, social, economic, and other services. It likewise covers: (a) all the regular budgetary items for the operations of the different municipal offices broken down into PS, MOOE, Financial Expenses and Capital Outlay; (b) the priority development programs/projects and those to be funded by the 20% development fund, and; (c) disaster risk reduction management programs/projects/activities of the municipality. It further includes the following: 1) Gender and Development Plan, Peace and Order Plan and Anti-Drug Abuse Council Action Plan, Local Nutrition Action Plan, and Tourism/Cultural Development Plan, Climate Change Action Plan, Local Youth Development Plan, Annual Procurement Plan, and; 2) list of programs/projects/activities for the Local Council for Protection of Children, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities, PPAs to combat Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome;

- 3. The proposed AIP has a total investment requirement of Php 295,370,005.00 which will be funded from the municipality's proposed 2025 Annual Budget enacted on October 28, 2024 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 03, Series of 2024;
- The development fund amounting to Php 45,250,601.00 which is allocated for development projects, is equivalent to 20% of the municipality's NTA amounting to Php 226,253,005.00 for CY 2025. This is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160;
- The identified development programs/projects to be funded by the 20% of NTA are based on the DILG-DOF-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects);
- 6. The identified programs/projects/activities to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the municipality amounting to Php 14,768,500.00 conforms with Section 21 of RA 10121. The 70 % of the 5% LDRRMF amounting to Php10,337,950.00 is allocated for disaster risk reduction programs/projects while 30 % on a total amount of Php 4,430,550.00 is set aside for Quick Response Fund. It is recommended however that the utilization of the 70 % of the 5 % LDRRMF shall be in accordance with NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). Further, the LDRRMF Plan 2021-2025 of the municipality was reviewed by the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) as per attached OCD Certification dated August 30, 2024;





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- The LGU has also identified programs/projects/activities responsive to climate change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015; and
- 8. The Gender and Development Plan of the municipality has been reviewed by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and was found to be fully compliant in form and contents with the provisions of the Joint Memo Circular of 2016-01: Amendments to JMC 2013-01 re: Guidelines on Localization of the Magna Carta of Women as per attached Certificate of Review and Endorsement of the DILG dated May 31, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Sison, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Rosary Gracia P. Perez-Tababa and Nicholi Jan Louie Q. Sison and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was-

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve SB Resolution No. 2024-302 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Sison, Pangasinan, entitled "Approving the Annual Investment Program-CY 2025 of the Municipality of Sison, Province of Pangasinan";

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Sison, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
