RESOLUTION NO. 132-2023

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 63, S-2022 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MAPANDAN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN NO. 5, CY 2022 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MAPANDAN, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mapandan, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 63, S-20222 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. The Municipal Development Council of Mapandan, Pangasinan prepared the municipality's Supplemental Annual Investment Plan No. 5, CY 2022. This was endorsed by the Council, through MDC Resolution No. 08, S. 2022 dated November 11, 2022, to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval;
2. Said Supplemental Annual Investment Program, which has a total investment requirement of ₱6,593,298.60, covers fund augmentation for Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay (CO) of some offices of the Municipal Government, and implementation of LDRR projects/activities and development projects of the LGU;



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3. The project proposed to be funded from the 20% Development Fund were based on the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects). Likewise, the proposed LDRRM projects were based on NDRRMC-DILG-DBM JMC No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund), except for the project, Installation of Solar Lights; and
4. Funding for the Supplemental AIP of the LGU is embodied in their Supplemental Budget No. 5, CY 2022, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 5, Series of 2022 dated November 28, 2022 and approved by Municipal Mayor on December 9, 2022.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Mapandan, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Shiela Marie F. Baniqued and Vici M. Ventanilla and co-sponsored by SP Members Jerome Vic O. Espino, Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan and Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 63, S-2022 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Mapandan, Pangasinan, entitled “Approving the Supplemental Annual Investment Plan No. 5, CY 2022 of the Municipality of Mapandan, Pangasinan”;
