### RESOLUTION NO. 133-2025

**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 417, S-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN"**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Basista, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 417, S-2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Coordinator have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject Resolution is in consonance to Section 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991. The Municipal Development Council of Basista, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for CY 2025. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan through MDC Resolution No. 3, Series of 2024 dated September 25, 2024, and was favorably acted upon by the Sangguniang Bayan through SB Resolution No. 417, Series of 2024 dated October 28, 2024;
2. The Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition, and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-1 dated July 23, 2015 as to form and

content. The AIP of Basista was prepared using the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: (a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different offices broken down into Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Financial Expenses (FE) and Capital Outlay, (b) priority development programs/projects of the LGU, including those funded by the 20% Development Fund, (c) Disaster-Risk Reduction (DRR) programs, projects, and activities, and (d) activities in pursuance of the objectives of Gender and Development (GAD) of the LGU as indicated in the DILG-endorsed GAD Plan and Budget;

Also attached to the AIP are the following: (a) Local Climate Change Action Plan, (b) Peace and Order Plan, (c) Local youth Development Plan (d) Local Nutrition Action Plan (e) Annual Cultural Development Plan, (f) Indicative Annual Procurement Plan, (g) Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP), (h) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, (i) List of PPAs for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability, (j) List of PPAs to Combat Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome, and (j) List of PPAs to Address the Problems on Illegal Drugs of the LGU;

The proposed AIP of Basista for CY 2024 has a total investment requirement of P495,159,179.13. Of this, P189,199,179.13 will be financed by the LGU as embodied in their proposed Annual Budget for CY 2025 which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 3, Series of 2024 dated October 28, 2024, and was approved by the Municipal Mayor on November 15, 2024. The remaining amount of P305,960,000.00 will be for outsourcing;

3. This AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of LGC of 1991. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGU's IRA/NTA (P169,199,180.00), amounting to P33,839,836.00, is allocated for development projects. However, it is recommended that the programs, projects, and activities proposed to be funded from the 20% Development Fund (DF) shall be in accordance with DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the appropriation and utilization of the Twenty Percent (20%) of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects);
4. The attached Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Programs/Projects/Activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the LGU amounting to P9,459,959.00 conform with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs/projects to be funded from the 70% of the LDRRMF, in the amount of P6,621,971.30 are based on the NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March

25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund) and the 30% amounting to P2,837,987.70 is allocated for Quick Response Fund (QRF);

5. The LGU of Basista had also identified programs, projects and activities which are responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015; and
6. The Gender and Development Plan and Budget for CY 2025 of the LGU was reviewed and approved by the DILG Provincial Office, and found to be compliant in form and content with the provisions of the PCW-DILG-DBM-NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) Nos. 2013-01 and 2016-01 (Guidelines on the Localization of the Magna Carta of Women).


**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Basista, Pangasinan;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Philip Theodore E. Cruz and Haidee S. Pacheco and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—


