RESOLUTION NO. 149-2023

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 4 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 OF BANI, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF P6,723,813.91, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bani, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 4 for Calendar Year 2022 involving total appropriations of P6,723,813.91, which was enacted on December 12, 2022 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 05, Series of 2022;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted review and study on said budget with the following findings:

- That the funding sources for the subject supplemental budget were determined in accordance to Section 321 of R.A. 7160 and Article 417
 (a) of its IRR as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;
- That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of R.A.9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

- 3. That the grant of Other Bonus-Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) to regular & casual employees for FY 2022 shall be subject to the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2022-4 dated December 20, 2022; and
- 4. That the appropriation for Collective Negotiation Agreement (CNA) Incentive for FY 2022 to all municipal officials & employees shall be subject to the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2022-3 of the Department of Budget & Management dated October 19, 2022, particularly Item 4.3.6 thereof.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Napoleon C. Fontelera, Jr. and Apolonia DG. Bacay and co-sponsored by SP Members Jerome Vic O. Espino, Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan and Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Operative in its Entirety the Supplemental Budget No. 4 for Calendar Year 2022 of Bani, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Bani, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
