**RESOLUTION NO. 150-2025**

**DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 2 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 OF STA. MARIA, PANGASINAN, INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P4,700,717.40, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 2 for Calendar Year 2024 involving total appropriations of P4,700,717.40, which was enacted on December 12, 2024 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 24-06;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That the funding sources for the subject Supplemental Budget were determined in accordance with Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160 and Article 417(a) of its IRR, as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;
2. That the reversion of savings from the Personal Services (PS) shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 336 of R.A. 7160 (Use of Appropriated Funds and Savings);





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3. That all programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and FY 2024 Annual Investment Program of the municipality and its Supplements thereto, formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated 08 March 2007;
4. That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;
5. That the items funded out of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund shall be in accordance with R. A. No. 10121 Known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act 2010 and its IRR and the DBM-NDRRMC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 re: Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and that 30% shall be set aside as Quick Response Fund);
6. That the projects funded under the 20% of the Annual National Tax Allotment for development projects (20% Development Fund) shall be subject to the provisions of DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 re: "Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the twenty percent (20%) of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects.";
7. That the grant of Gratuity Pay to Contract of Service and Job Order Workers in Government for FY 2024 shall be in accordance with the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2024-8 dated December 20, 2024 by the Department of Budget and Management;
8. That the appropriation for Other Personnel Benefits-Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) to government employees for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be in accordance with the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2024-7 dated December 16, 2024 by the Department of Budget and Management; and
9. That the utilization of appropriations from shares of the Municipality from Burley and Native Tobacco Excise Tax Collections shall be subject to the provisions of Local Budget Memorandum No. 91 dated August 29, 2024.

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Noel C. Bince and Salvador S. Perez, Jr. and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—



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
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
