RESOLUTION NO. 176-2023

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 2022-134 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF TAYUG, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL AIP PURSUANT TO APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2022-004 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYUG, PANGASINAN INVOLVING AN AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (P3,420,000.00)"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Tayug, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 2022-134 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject resolution is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991. The Local Development Council of Tayug, Pangasinan has identified items in their Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 2. This was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan on December 23, 2022 through MDC Resolution No. 2022-5;

2. The SIP of the municipality covers fund augmentation for Personal Services (granting of Service Recognition Incentive of municipal officials and employees of LGU Tayug), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses and Capital Outlay of the Office of the Mayor and Sangguniang Bayan; and
3. Funding support for the proposed SIP, with a total investment requirement of PhP3,420,000.00 is embodied in the municipality's Supplemental Budget No. 2, which was approved and enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No.2022-004 on December 27, 2022.




