DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 07 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 OF SUAL, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF P6,319,000.00, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

1. That the funding source for the subject Supplemental Budget was determined in accordance with Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160 and Article 417(a) of its IRR as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;

- 2. That all programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and the FY 2022 Annual/Supplemental Investment Program of the municipality formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated 08 March 2007;
- 3. That the reversion of savings from the Personal Services and Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 336 of R.A. 7160 (Use of Appropriated Funds and Savings); and
- 4. That the grant of Other Personnel Benefits Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) to regular and casual employees for Fiscal Year 2022 shall be subject to the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2022-04 dated December 20, 2022.
