RESOLUTION NO. 198-2025

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 2024-179 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BOLINAO, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “TO ADOPT THE DETAILS OF THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) CY 2025 AS EMBODIED IN THE RESOLUTION NUMBER 5, SERIES OF 2024 OF THE MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF BOLINAO, PANGASINAN”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bolinao, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 2024-179 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. In pursuance to Sections 106, 109, and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipal Development Council of Bolinao, Pangasinan has formulated its Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2025, which was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval through Resolution No. 5, Series of 2024 dated October 9, 2024;
2. The AIP of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for LGUs, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007 DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015. The AIP of Bolinao, Pangasinan was categorized into general public, social, economic, and other services. It likewise covers: (a) all the



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regular budgetary items for the operations of the different municipal offices broken down into PS, MOOE, and Capital Outlay; (b) the priority development programs/projects and those to be funded by the 20% development fund, and; (c) disaster risk reduction management programs/projects/activities of the municipality. It further includes the following: 1) Annual Gender and Development Plan and Budget, Peace and Order and Public Safety Plan, Local Nutrition Action Plan, Annual Cultural Development Plan, Local Climate Change Action Plan, Local Youth Development Plan, Annual Procurement Plan, and; 2) list of programs/projects/activities for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, Aid to Senior Citizens and Persons with Special Needs, PPAs to combat AIDS and to address problems on illegal drugs. It is recommended however, that the LGU shall use the new prescribed AIP Summary Form in accordance to Local Budget Memorandum No. 87 dated June 9, 2023 in their next Annual/Supplemental Investment Program preparation;

3. The proposed AIP has a total investment requirement of Php439,992,774.00 which will be funded from the municipality's proposed 2025 Annual Budget enacted on November 7, 2024 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2024-03 amounting to Php434,792,774.00 and the remaining Php5,200,000.00 will be funded under Special Education Fund;
4. The development fund amounting to Php69,348,554.80, which is allocated for development projects, is equivalent to 20% of the municipality's NTA amounting to Php 346,742,774.00 for CY 2025. This is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160;
5. The identified development programs/projects to be funded by the 20% of NTA are based on the DILG-DOF-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects);
6. The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Programs/Projects/Activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5 % Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the municipality amounting to Php21,800,000.00 conforms with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs, projects and activities to be funded by the 70 % of the LDRRM Fund in the amount of Php 15,260,000.00 are based on NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). The remaining 30% amounting to Php6,540,000.00 is allocated for Quick Response Fund (QRF). The LDRRM Plan 2023-2028 of the LGU was reviewed by the



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Office of Civil Defense (OCD) as per attached OCD Certification dated June 30, 2023;

7. The LGU has also identified programs/projects/activities responsive to climate change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015; and
8. The Gender and Development Plan of the municipality has been reviewed by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and was found to be fully compliant in form and contents with the provisions of the Joint Memo Circular of 2016-01: Amendments to JMC 2013-01 re: Guidelines on Localization of the Magna Carta of Women as per attached Certificate of Review and Endorsement of the DILG dated May 29, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Bolinao, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Napoleon C. Fontelera, Jr. and Apolonia DG. Bacay and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—


