RESOLUTION NO. 204-2023

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 3 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF P4,143,876.62, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Basista, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 3 for Calendar Year 2022 involving total appropriations of Php4,143,876.62, which was enacted on December 23, 2022 through Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance No. 4, Series of 2022;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That the funding sources for the subject supplemental budget were determined in accordance to Section 321 of R.A 7160 and Article 414 (a) of its IRR as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;



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2. That the utilization of appropriations from 20% Development Fund shall be in accordance with the provisions of DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 re: “Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects”;
3. That all programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and FY 2022 Supplemental Investment Program of the municipality formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated 08 March 2007;
4. That all procurement to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of R.A. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;
5. That the grant of Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) to qualified municipal employees for FY 2022 shall be subject to the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2022-4 dated December 20, 2022; and
6. That the reversion of savings from Personal Services and MOOE shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 336 of RA 7160 (Use of Appropriated Funds and Savings).

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Philip Theodore E. Cruz and Haidee S. Pacheco and co-sponsored by SP Members Jerome Vic O. Espino, Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan and Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Operative in Its Entirety the Supplemental Budget No. 3 for Calendar Year 2022 of Basista, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Basista, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
