### RESOLUTION NO. 208-2023

**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 257-11282022 OF THE SANGGUNIAN BAYAN OF POZORRUBIO, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POZORRUBIO, PANGASINAN FOR CY 2023 FUNDED BY THE GENERAL FUND, 20% DEVELOPMENT FUND, 5% LDRRM FUND AND NATIONAL TAX ALLOTMENT OF THE LGU FOR 2023"**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Pozorrubio, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 257-11282022 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. In pursuance to Sections 106, 109, and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipal Development Council of Pozorrubio, Pangasinan has formulated the municipality's Annual Investment Program for CY 2023, which was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval through MDC Resolution No. 03, Series 2022 dated October 6, 2022;

2. The AIP of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for LGUs, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007 DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Pozorrubio, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form categorized into general public, social, economic, and other services. It likewise covers: (a) all the regular budgetary items for the operations of the different municipal government offices broken down into PS, MOOE, and Capital Outlay; (b) the priority development programs/projects and those to be funded by the 20% development fund, and; (c) disaster risk reduction management programs/projects/activities of the municipality. It further includes the following: 1) Gender and Development Plan, Peace and Order Program, Local Nutrition Action Plan, Tourism, Culture and the Arts Development Plan, Climate Change Action Plan, Local Youth Development Action Plan, Annual Procurement Plan, and; 2) list of programs/projects/activities for the Protection of Children, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities, PPAs to combat HIV and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS), and to address Problems on Illegal Drugs;
3. The AIP has a total investment requirement amounting to Php 284,432,559.67 which will be funded from the municipality's proposed 2023 Annual Budget, enacted on November 28, 2022 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 03-11282022, Series of 2022 and approved by the Municipal Mayor on December 13, 2022;
4. The development fund amounting to Php 56,000,000.00, which is allocated for development projects is more than the 20% (Php47,996,927.20) of the municipality's NTA amounting to Php 239,984,636.00 for CY 2023. This is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160;
5. The identified development programs/projects to be funded by the 20% of NTA are based on the DILG-DOF-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects);

6. The identified programs/projects/activities to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the municipality amounting to PhP14,500,000.00, which is more than the required 5% (PhP13,573,731.80) of the municipality's regular income (PhP271,474,636.00), conforms with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs/projects/ activities to be funded by 70% of the LDRRM Fund are based on the NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). It is respectfully recommended that the LDRRM Plan be submitted to the OCD for review as provided under Item no. 2.2.12 of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) – Local Budget Memorandum (LBM) No.77 dated May 15, 2018 and DBM Local Budget Memorandum Circular No. 82 dated June 14, 2021;
7. The LGU has also identified programs/projects/activities responsive to climate change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015; and
8. The Gender and Development Plan of the municipality has been reviewed by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and was found to be fully compliant in form and contents with the provisions of the Joint Memo Circular of 2016-01: Amendments to JMC 2013-01 re: Guidelines on Localization of the Magna Carta of Women as per attached Certificate of Review and Endorsement of the DILG dated March 29, 2022.

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Pozorrubio, Pangasinan;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Rosary Gracia P. Perez-Tababa and Nicholi Jan Louie Q. Sison and co-sponsored by SP Members Jerome Vic O. Espino, Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan and Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., duly seconded, it was—


