APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 138, S-2023 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SIP) NO. 1 FOR CY 2023 OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN"

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Basista, Pangasinan, submitted its SB Resolution No. 138, Series of 2023 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

- The Municipal Development Council of Basista, Pangasinan prepared their Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 1 for CY 2023. This was endorsed by the Council, through MDC Resolution No. 1, Series of 2023 dated February 16, 2023, to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval;
- Said Supplemental Annual Investment Program, which has a total investment requirement of ₱3,660,726.30, covers augmentation of funds for Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay (CO), and implementation of development project/s of the LGU;

- 3. The new/proposed project to be funded from the reversion of the sum of P1,900,000.00 from the 20% Development Fund, CY 2023 conforms with the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects); and
- Funding for the Supplemental AIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 1, FY 2023, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 1, Series of 2023 dated February 27, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Basista, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Philip Theodore E. Cruz and Haidee S. Pacheco and co-sponsored by SP Members Jerome Vic O. Espino, Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan and Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., duly seconded, it was—
