## **RESOLUTION NO. 60-2023**

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 135, S-2022 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF CALASIAO, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN/PROGRAM (SAIP) (FUNDED BY THE 20% INTERNAL REVENUE ALLOTMENT AND OTHER SOURCES) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALASIAO, FOR THE YEAR 2022"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Calasiao, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 135, S-2022 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

- The Municipal Development Council Executive Committee of Calasiao, Pangasinan has prepared the municipality's Supplemental Annual Investment Program for CY 2022. This was endorsed by the Council, through MDC Resolution No. 07, Series of 2022 dated November 18, 2022, to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval;
- Said Supplemental Annual Investment Program, which has a total investment requirement of ₱38,895,497.15, covers the augmentation of funds for Personal Services (PS), MOOE and Capital Outlay (CO) of LGU offices, and implementation of development projects, LDRRM projects/activities and GAD-related activities of the Municipal Government;

- 3. The proposed projects to be funded from the 20% Development Fund conform with the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the IRA for Development Projects). Likewise, the identified projects/activities to be financed from the 5% LDRRM Fund is in pursuance to the NDRRMC-DILG-DBM JMC No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of the LDRRM Fund); and
- Funding for the Supplemental AIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 2, FY 2022, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 08, Series of 2022 dated November 21, 2022.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Calasiao, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Shiela Marie F. Baniqued and Vici M. Ventanilla and co-sponsored by SP Members Jerome Vic O. Espino, Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan and Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., duly seconded, it was—

**RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 135, S-2022 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Calasiao, Pangasinan, entitled "Approving the Supplemental Annual Investment Plan/Program (SAIP) (Funded by the 20% Internal Revenue Allotment and Other Sources) of the Municipality of Calasiao, for the Year 2022";
