#### **APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 23-036 OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF SAN CARLOS, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SIP) NO. 2 FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2023 OF THE CITY OF SAN CARLOS, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN”**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of San Carlos, Pangasinan submitted its SP Resolution No. 23-036 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SP Resolution with the following findings:

1. The City Development Council – Executive Committee of San Carlos City, Pangasinan prepared the Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 2, CY 2023. This was endorsed by the Council, through CDC Resolution No. 03-23 (Series of 2023) dated March 9, 2023, to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for approval. This is in accordance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991;
2. Said Supplemental Investment Program (SIP), which has a total investment requirement of ₱32,693,225.15, covers the augmentation of funds for Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay (CO) of various offices of the City Government, and implementation of priority projects of the LGU; and

3. Funding for the implementation of the SIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 02-23, FY 2023, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Panlungsod through Appropriation Ordinance No. 23-02, dated March 20, 2023 and approved by the Mayor on March 24, 2023.


**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the City Government of San Carlos, Pangasinan;
