PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 926-2023

EXPRESSING PROFOUND SYMPATHY AND SINCERE CONDOLENCES TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE MARJORETTE GARCIA, A NATIVE DAUGHTER OF SAN JACINTO, PANGASINAN AND A SAUDI ARABIA-BASED OVERSEAS FILIPINO WORKER (OFW), WHO WAS MURDERED IN THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA (KSA)

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2023, the Department of Migrant Workers has confirmed the death of Marjorette Garcia who was found with stab wounds, allegedly inflicted by her African co-worker, and was taken to a hospital where she was pronounced dead;

WHEREAS, the late Marjorette Garcia, a 32-year-old domestic worker who hails from Barangay Awai, San Jacinto, Pangasinan, had started working in Saudi Arabia in 2021 and had just extended her contract and was supposed to return to the country by October this year;

WHEREAS, the Garcia family lost a loved one and mourns painfully over the tragic demise of Marjorette Garcia, who had opted to become a migrant worker and left her home in order to provide a comfortable life for her family;

WHEREAS, the senseless act of violence committed by the perpetrator against Marjorette Garcia had left an irreparable loss and grief to the hearts and minds of her family, especially to her husband and her two children aged 9 and 6 years old;

WHEREAS, the people of the Province of Pangasinan, particularly her hometown, San Jacinto, are deeply saddened by the untimely passing of the late Marjorette Garcia;

WHEREAS, despite desolation and bereavement, the Province of Pangasinan is honoring her excellent service as an Overseas Filipino Worker - an unsung modern-day hero whose hardwork and sacrifice for her family is truly worthy of emulation;


