WHEREAS, the Toyo University Graduate School of International Tourism organized the Toyo University Tourism Short Film Festival with the theme "Tourism and Sustainable Society", which is part of the tourism innovation projects being undertaken by Toyo University with the University of Ca'Foscari in Venice since 2019;

WHEREAS, inspired by the Film Festival of the University of Ca'Foscari, this year's short film festival, which has regional ties and international reach, was organized specifically focusing on issues concerning tourism and sustainable society that are now the focus of countries around the world;

WHEREAS, the short film "Ang Himala sa Kamay ng Daang Tao", showcasing the culture, arts, and tourism of Alaminos City in the International Stage, bagged the Student Award in the 2nd Toyo University Tourism Short Film Festival Awards in Tokyo, Japan last December 1, 2022;



WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Members Apolonia DG. Bacay and Napoleon C. Fontelera, Jr. - duly seconded it was -


