RESOLUTION NO. 408-2025

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 003 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 OF MALASIQUI, PANGASINAN, INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P23,462,927.58, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 003 for Calendar Year 2024 involving total appropriations of P23,462,927.58, which was enacted on December 16, 2024 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 004-2024;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That the funding sources for the subject Supplemental Budget were determined in accordance with Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160 and Article 417(a) of its IRR, as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;



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2. That the reversion of savings shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 336 of R.A. No. 7160 (Use of Appropriated Funds and Savings);
3. That all Procurements to be undertaken shall be in accordance with the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;
4. That all programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and the FY 2024 Annual Investment Program of the municipality and its supplements thereto, formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007, dated 08 March 2007;
5. That the grant of Other Personal Benefits-Service Recognition Incentives (SRI) to government employees for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be in accordance with the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2024-7 dated December 16, 2024 by the Department of Budget and Management;
6. That the grant of Other Personnel Benefits-Collective Negotiation Agreement (CNA) Incentive for FY 2024 to government employees shall be in accordance with the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2024-4 dated November 11, 2024 of the Department of Budget and Management;
7. That the Grant of Gratuity Pay to Contract of Service and Job Order Workers in Government for FY 2024 shall be in accordance with the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2024-8 dated December 20, 2024 of the Department of Budget and Management;
8. That the Grant of Performance Based Bonus (PBB) shall be in accordance with the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2023-1 dated August 22, 2023 by the Department of Budget and Management; and
9. That the items funded out of the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Fund shall be in accordance with R.A. No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Act of 2010 and its IRR, and the DBM-NDRRM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 re: Allocation & Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Fund (LDRRMF) & that 30% shall be set aside as Quick Response Fund.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;



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WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Shiela Marie F. Baniqued and Vici M. Ventanilla and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—


