RESOLUTION NO. 415-2025

APPROVING SB RESOLUTION NO. 194-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MANAOAG, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MANAOAG, PANGASINAN”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Manaoag, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 194-2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject Resolution is in consonance to Sections 106, 109, and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991. The Municipal Development Council of Manaoag, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for CY 2024. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan through MDC Resolution No. 04, Series of 2024 dated August 19, 2024;
2. The Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2023 Edition pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No.1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007, DBM-CCC-DILG-JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-1 dated July 3, 2015 as to format and content. The



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AIP of Manaoag is categorized into general public, social, economic and other services sectors, and covers (a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different offices broken down into Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Financial Expenses (FE), and Capital Outlay, (b) priority development programs/projects of the LGU, including those funded by the 20% Development Fund, (c) Disaster-Risk Reduction (DRR) programs, projects and activities, and (d) activities in pursuance of the objectives of Gender and Development (GAD) of the LGU as indicated in the DILG-endorsed GAD Plan and Budget.

Also attached to the AIP, among others, are the following: (a) Local Climate Change Action Plan, (b) Peace and Order Plan, (c) Local Youth Development Plan, (d) Municipal Nutrition Plan, (e) Annual Cultural Development Plan, (f) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, (g) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for Senior Citizens and PWDs, (h) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) to Combat HIV/AIDS (i) PPAs to Address the Problems on Illegal Drugs, and (j) Indicative Annual Procurement Plan of the LGU.

It is recommended however, that the LGU shall use the new prescribed AIP Summary Form in their succeeding AIPs and Supplemental AIPs as per Local Budget Memorandum No. 87 dated June 9, 2023;

3. The proposed AIP of Manaoag for CY 2025 has a total investment requirement of P322,680,000.00. This will be funded by the LGU as embodied in their 2025 Annual Budget which was approved and enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 04, Series of 2024 dated November 12, 2024;
4. The AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of LGC of 1991. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGU's IRA/NTA (P283,074,561.00), amounting to P56,614,912.20, is allocated for development projects.

The development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% Development Fund were based on the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects).

It is respectfully recommended, however, that the project; "Purchase of 3 units Brand New Rescue Vehicle for Brgys. Lelemaan, Pantal and Pao", with a total project cost of Php 1,800,000.00, shall be used for its intended purpose, and not for administrative purposes, in compliance with Section 3.2.5.6 of the aforementioned Joint DBM-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020.



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Also, the project “Barangay Infrastructure Projects Assistance (for regravelling of Brgy. Roads, Farm to Market Roads, Construction Materials for repair of drainage canals and health centers, multi-purpose halls, etc.)” shall be specified;

5. The attached Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Programs/Projects/Activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the LGU amounting to P15,900,000.00 conform with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs/projects to be funded from the 70% of the LDRRMF, in the amount of P11,130,000.00 are based on the NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund) and the 30% amounting to P4,770,000.00 is allocated for Quick Response Fund (QRF).

The LDRRM Plan was reviewed and validated by the Office of Civil Defense - Regional Office I through the Local DRRM Plan (2021-2026) of the LGU;

6. The LGU had also identified programs, projects and activities which are responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding typology code and objective result indicator in their AIP. However, it is recommended that the Climate Change expenditures be also tagged as per DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015; and
7. The Gender and Development Plan and Budget for CY 2025 of the LGU was reviewed and approved by the DILG Provincial Office, and found to be compliant in form and content with the provisions of PCW-DILG-DBM-NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular Nos. 2013-01 and 2016-01 (Guidelines on the Localization of the Magna Carta of Women).

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Manaoag, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Marinor B. De Guzman and Jerry Agerico B. Rosario and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve SB Resolution No. 194, S-2024 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Manaoag, Pangasinan, entitled “Approving the Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2025 of the Municipality of Manaoag, Pangasinan”;



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
