RESOLUTION NO. 563-2025

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 24-215 OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF SAN CARLOS, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "A RESOLUTION REAPPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-FIVE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWELVE THOUSAND SIX **HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE PESOS AND NINETY-TWO CENTAVOS** (P35,812,659.92) FROM THE BALANCES OF 20% DEVELOPMENT **FUND** 2018-2023 TO THE **VARIOUS PRIORITY** CY PROJECTS IDENTIFIED BY THE CITY DEVELOPMENT DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL AND THE SAME SERVING AS SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SIP) NO. 11 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 OF THE CITY OF SAN CARLOS, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of San Carlos, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 24-215 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Coordinator of the Pangasinan has conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. The City Development Council of San Carlos City, Pangasinan prepared the Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 11, CY 2024. This was endorsed by the Council, through CDC Execom Resolution No. 16-24 (Series of 2024) dated October 28, 2024, to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for approval. This is in accordance with Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991;

- 2. The Supplemental Investment Program (SIP), which has a total investment requirement of PhP35,812,659.92, covers the implementation of various development projects of the LGU;
- 3. The proposed projects to be funded from the Unutilized Appropriation from prior year's 20% Development Fund (2018-2023) conform with Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects); and
- 4. Funding support for the implementation of the SIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 12(A)-24, CY 2024, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Panlungsod through Appropriation Ordinance No. 24-21(a) dated November 19, 2024, and approved by the Local Chief Executive on November 22, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the City Government of San Carlos, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Member Napoleon C. Fontelera, Jr., duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 24-215 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of San Carlos, Pangasinan, entitled "A Resolution reappropriating the amount of Thirty-Five Million Eight Hundred Twelve Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-Nine Pesos and Ninety-Two Centavos (P35,812,659.92) from the balances of 20% Development Fund CY 2018-2023 to the various priority development projects identified by the City Development Council and the same serving as Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 11 for Calendar Year 2024 of the City of San Carlos, Province of Pangasinan";

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of San Carlos, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
