APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 104-2025 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MALASIQUI, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM NO. 001-2025 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MALASIQUI, PANGASINAN”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 104-2025 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject resolution is in consonance with Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991. The Local Development Council of Malasiqui, Pangasinan has identified items in their Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) No. 1, CY 2025. This was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval on May 16, 2025, by the Municipal Development Council through MDC Resolution No. 1, Series of 2025;
2. Said Supplemental Annual Investment Program, which has an investment requirement of P120,907367.99, covers fund augmentation for the Personal Services (granting of Performance-Based Bonus to qualified officials and employees and other Personal Services), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), and Capital Outlay of some municipal offices, and the implementation of other priority development programs/projects of the LGU proposed to be funded from the loan proceeds from the Development Bank of the Philippines; and

3. Funding for the full implementation of the Supplemental AIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 1, CY 2025, which was enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 001-2025 dated July 21, 2025.


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Malasiqui, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Member Napoleon C. Fontelera, Jr., duly seconded, it was—


