EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 0016-A, SERIES OF 2023

AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 0016, SERIES OF 2023 ENTITLED "EXTENDING A TEMPORARY TOTAL BAN ON THE ENTRY OF ALL DUCKS, QUAILS, SPENT HENS (CULLED), HATCHING EGGS, PIGEONS, GAMEFOWLS, READY TO LAY PULLET (RTL), AND THE RESTRICTIONS ON THE MOVEMENT OF OTHER POULTRY BIRDS AND BY PRODUCTS FROM THE PROVINCES OF BULACAN, PAMPANGA, NUEVA ECIJA, TARLAC, LAGUNA, SULTAN KUDARAT, BENGUET, NORTH COTABATO, SOUTH COTABATO, MAGUINDANAO, ISABELA, QUEZON, KALINGA, AURORA, ILOCOS NORTE, ILOCOS SUR, CAPIZ, AND BATANGAS INTO THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the State is mandated to protect and promote the right to health of people and are empowered to exercise necessary, appropriate, and incidental powers for efficient governance in promotion of general welfare,

WHEREAS, due to the continuous spread and increasing number of Avian Influenza in the country, there is a need to amend the documentary requirements cited in the Executive Order No. 0016, series of 2023, to safeguard the poultry industry as well as to protect the general public from the ill effects of the Bird Flu disease in the province.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RAMON V. GUICO III, Governor of the Province of Pangasinan, Philippines, and by virtue of the powers vested upon me by the law, do hereby amend the documentary requirements and compliance of the same which shall be effective until June 30, 2023:

SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY OF ALL DUCKS, QUAILS, SPENT HENS (CULLED), HATCHING EGGS, PIGEONS, GAMEFOWLS, AND READY TO LAY PULLET (RTL). The following documentary requirements must be presented in the Animal Quarantine Checkpoints, to wit:

- a. Broiler
 - i. Veterinary Health Certificate;
 - ii. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
 - iii. Animal Welfare Registration Certificate;
 - iv. Certificate of Disease-Free Status-A1;
 - v. Handler's License Certificate of Registration;
 - vi. Transport Carrier Registration Certificate;
 - vii. Certificate of Acceptance.
- b. Day Old Chick Hatching Eggs
 - i. Veterinary Health Certificate;
 - ii. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
 - iii. Animal Disease Monitoring Compliance Certificate (ADMCC) Handler's License Certificate of Registration;

- iv. Transport Carrier Registration Certificate
- v. Certificate of Acceptance.
- c. Eggs (Table Eggs, Salted Eggs, Quail eggs, Embryonated Eggs/Balut)
 - i. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
 - ii. Certificate of Disease-Free Status-A1 of Source Farm;
 - iii. Livestock Handler's License Certificate of Registration;
 - iv. Transport Carrier Registration Certificate;
 - v. <u>Certificate of Acceptance</u>.
- d. Fresh Poultry Meat and Frozen Poultry Meat
 - i. Certificate of Meat Inspection (Imported);
 - ii. Meat Inspection Certificate (Local);
 - iii. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
 - iv. Certificate of Acceptance.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other executive issuance, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Order are hereby revoked, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION3. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until subsequently amended/revoked/revised.

Dear Governor.

Greetings with peace and prosperity!

This is in reference to the updated Avian Influenza Status of our country and the existing Executive Order No. 0016, Series of 2023.

As of March 2023, the provinces with confirmed cases of Avian Influenza and have not yet recovered their Ai-Free Status are provinces of Bulacan, Pampanga, Nueva Ecija, Tarlac, Laguna, Sultan Kudarat, Benguet, North Cotabato, Maguindanao, Isabela, Pangasinan, Kalinga, Aurora, Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, Capiz, Batangas and Cagayan.

Upon reviewing our existing and in effect Executive Order No. 0016, Series of 2023 there is a need also to regulate the entry of table eggs, salted eggs, embryonated eggs (balut) and broiler into the province. Since eggs, egg trays and poultry meat can be a source of Avian Influenza virus that can be transmitted both poultry birds and human through direct contant.

In view of the foregoing, may we respectfully recommend for the amending of Executive Order No. 0016 Series of 2023, Letters A for broiler and C under table eggs, to include Certificate of **Acceptance** as one of the requirements for the entry into the Province of Pangasinan.

Furthermore, as of this date, Pangasinan has maintained its status of no active and confirmed case of Avian Influenza.

Also, attached hereto Avian Influenza Status Update from Bureau of Animal Industry.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 0016, SERIES OF 2023

AN ORDER EXTENDING A TEMPORARY TOTAL BAN ON THE ENTRY OF ALL DUCKS, QUAILS, SPENT HENS (CULLED), HATCHING EGGS, PIGEONS, GAMEFOWLS, READY TO LAY PULLET (RTL), AND THE RESTRICTIONS ON THE MOVEMENT OF OTHER POULTRY BIRDS AND BY PRODUCTS FROM THE PROVINCES OF BULACAN, PAMPANGA, NUEVA ECIJA, TARLAC, LAGUNA, SULTAN KUDARAT, BENGUET, NORTH COTABATO, SOUTH COTABATO, MAGUINDANAO, ISABELA, QUEZON, KALINGA, AURORA, ILOCOS NORTE, ILOCOS SUR, CAPIZ, AND BATANGAS INTO THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution and Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that Local Government Units within their territorial jurisdiction shall promote health and safety of the people;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 0005, series of 2023 was issued dated February 2, 2023 implementing a temporary total ban on the entry of All Ducks, Quails, Spent Hens (Culled), Hatching Eggs, Pigeons, Gamefowls, Ready to Lay Pullet (RTL) into the Province of Pangasinan from February 2, 2023 to March 2, 2023;

WHEREAS, to date, Pangasinan has no reported cases of Avian Influenza, however, with the continuing discovery of positive cases of Avian Influenza in the Province of Bulacan and other nearby provinces, there is a need to extend the temporary total ban on the entry of all ducks, quails, spent hens (culled), hatching eggs, pigeons, gamefowls, ready to lay pullet (RTL), to contain the spread of Avian Influenza and for the welfare of the residents of Pangasinan.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RAMON V. GUICO III, Governor of the Province of Pangasinan, Philippines, and by virtue of the powers vested upon me by the law, hereby extends the Temporary Total Ban in the entire Province of Pangasinan from March 3, 2023 to June 30, 2023.

All necessary documentary requirements in the Animal quarantine Checkpoints mentioned in EO No. 0005, series of 2023 is hereby reiterated, as follows:

a. Broiler

- i. Veterinary Health Certificate;
- ii. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
- iii. Animal Welfare Registration Certificate;
- iv. Certificate of Disease-Free Status-A1;
- v. Handler's License Certificate of Registration;
- vi. Transport Carrier Registration Certificate.

- b. Day Old Chick Hatching Eggs
 - i. Certificate of Acceptance;
 - ii. Veterinary Health Certificate:
 - iii. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
 - iv. Animal Disease Monitoring Compliance Certificate (ADMCC) Handler's License Certificate of Registration;
 - v. Transport Carrier Registration Certificate.
- c. Eggs (Table Eggs, Salted Eggs, Quail eggs, Embryonated Eggs/Balut)
 - i. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
 - ii. Certificate of Disease-Free Status-A1 of Source Farm;
 - iii. Livestock Handler's License Certificate of Registration;
 - iv. Transport Carrier Registration Certificate.
- d. Fresh Poultry Meat and Frozen Poultry Meat
 - i. Certificate of Meat Inspection (Imported);
 - ii. Meat Inspection Certificate (Local);
 - iii. Veterinary Shipping Permit;
 - iv. Certificate of Acceptance.

Strict compliance is hereby enjoined.
