#### **EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 0056, series 2023**

#### "RECONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (PADAC) OF THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, as part of the continuing efforts to promote and maintain peace, law and order in the community, there is a need for the creation of a multi-sectoral council to serve as a policy-making and coordinating body pursuant to the Department of the Interior and Local Government – Dangerous Drug Board Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government requires reconstitution of the Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council to include City/Municipal/Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Councils (C/M/BADACs) to curb illegal drugs and other hazardous substances;

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council has already been reconstituted from Executive Order No. 0144-A-2022 dated September 19, 2022;

WHEREAS, another reconstitution is necessary to replace members who have retired/promoted/reassigned from service; whose membership already does not serve the interest of the council; enhance functional accountability and assign a new set of support unit;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, **GOVERNOR RAMON V. GUICO III** by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. RECONSTITUTION OF THE PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL The Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) of the Province of Pangasinan is hereby reconstituted.

**Section 2. COMPOSITION.** The Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) of the Province of Pangasinan shall be composed of the following:

Section 3. FUNCTIONS. The Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) shall perform the following functions, to wit:

- Serves as the focal point of all anti-drug initiatives in the province through which various local government units, line agencies and organizations can look up, coordinate with and follow.
- Coordinate and work cooperatively to plan, implement and evaluate programs relative to drug abuse Prevention and Health Promotion; Law Enforcement; Penology, Rehabilitation / Reformation and Reintegration.
- 3. Coordinates existing programs in the province and those that may be developed in the future, to other organizations.
- 4. Provides funding mechanism, facilities and technical expertise.
- 5. Conducts information and education campaign on the ill-effect of illegal drugs.
- 6. Monitors and reports to authorities the drug-user, drug pushers, drug producers in the community, and
- 7. Performs other related functions and responsibilities as may be assigned by competent authorities.

Section 4. THE PROVINCIAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (PADAC) SECRETARIAT. The PADAC Secretariat is hereby created.

**Section 5. SECRETARIAT COMPOSITION.** The PADAC Secretariat shall be composed of 1 (one) Chairman, 2 (two) members for Advocacy and another 2 (two) for Monitoring. They are: be designated by the PADAC Chairman.

Section 6. PADAC SECRETARIAT FUNCTIONS: The Secretariat shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Assist the Chairperson in the conduct of PADAC meetings;
- 2. Recommend and prepare PADAC Agenda and other documents for the meetings;
- 3. Prepare resolutions of the Council and the minutes of the meeting;
- 4. Provide technical assistance in the performance of administrative and technical tasks of the PADAC;
- 5. Prepare, compile and submit documentation of all PADAC activities.
- 6. Prepare and submit accomplishment reports and other reports as may be necessary to all
- 7. Perform other functions as may be directed by the Council or the PADAC Chairman.

Section 7. MEETINGS. The PADAC shall meet at least quarterly and as may be necessary.

Section 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. All prior instances relative to this order are deemed repealed and any provision/s hereof found inconsistent with the national laws, orders and policies shall be deemed superseded by which law, order or policy.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY. This executive order shall take effect immediately. The PADAC is hereby authorized to convene immediately to discuss its plan of activities.
