RESOLUTION NO. 1007-2020

DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 13-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SAN JACINTO, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 217-2018 (AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE MORAL RECOVERY PROGRAM (MRP) IN THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of San Jacinto, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 13-2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 16 of RA 7160; the Preamble of the 1987 Philippine Constitution; Article II Section 21 of the Constitution's Declaration of Principles and State Policies; Proclamation No. 62 or the Moral Recovery Program; and Executive Order No. 319, entitled "Institutionalizing the Moral Recovery Program in all Government Departments, Officers, Agencies and Government-Owned and Controlled Corporations Through the Establishment of Integrity Circles";

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject ordinance in order;
