**RESOLUTION NO. 103-2021**

**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 250, S-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF STA. BARBARA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "CONCURRING/APPROVING MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (MDC) RESOLUTION NO. 2020-12, SERIES OF 2020 ENTITLED "ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE REVISED LOCAL RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND INVESTMENT PLAN (LDRRMFIP) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF STA. BARBARA, PANGASINAN CALENDAR YEAR 2020 AND ENDORSING IT TO THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN FOR APPROVAL"**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 250, Series of 2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the Municipal Development Council of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval the Revised Local Risk Reduction and Management Fund Investment Plan (LDRRMFIP) for CY 2020. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan through MDC Resolution No. 2020-12 dated October 13, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the LDRRMFIP of Sta. Barbara was revised to include additional DRRM-related projects and activities to be funded from the LDRRM Fund Unexpended Balances for CYs 2016-2019 amounting to a total of P4,069,138.91;
