PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 108-2004

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF STREAMERS, POSTERS, BANNERS AND OTHER SIMILAR FORM OF SIGNAGES IN THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR

EXPLANATORY NOTES

WHEREAS, numerous reports have been received pertaining to the indiscriminate posting, unscrupulous and disorderly display of streamers, posters and banners and other similar form of signages obstructing government boundary markers, directional signs, agency names and other public structures;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that when these materials are not properly secured or hanged, they oftentimes pose risk to pedestrians and motorists alike;

WHEREAS, the putting up of these signages sometimes present an eye-sore in the landscape and beauty of the province-wide thoroughfare;

WHEREAS, these signages are not properly removed or disposed off even after their purpose has been attained and cause litter along roads and other public places;
