## **PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 154-2011**

### **AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING “LUYAG KO TAN YAMAN” AS THE OFFICIAL PROVINCIAL HYMN OF PANGASINAN**

**WHEREAS**, after its long years of existence as a local government unit, Pangasinan has finally determined April 5, 1580 as its founding day;

**WHEREAS**, to further strengthen the impact of the fruition of having a founding day which from now on will be celebrated annually, the Province needs to adopt an official hymn that can showcase Pangasinan’s richness in culture, arts and traditions;

**WHEREAS**, the song “Luyag Ko Tan Yaman” has been composed and arranged in Pangasinan language with the end in view of instilling into the hearts and minds of every Pangasinense the love, loyalty, patriotism of one’s own home province and more so, in the protection and preservation of the environment;

**WHEREAS**, “Luyag Ko Tan Yaman” will be the official Provincial Hymn of Pangasinan which shall serve as an inspiration for the people of Pangasinan to be more united and determined towards the goal of attaining further peace, progress and development in the Province;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of SP Member Von Mark R. Mendoza, duly seconded, it was -

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in regular session, to ordain the following ordinance:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as “**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING “LUYAG KO TAN YAMAN” AS THE OFFICIAL PROVINCIAL HYMN OF PANGASINAN.**”

**SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this Ordinance, the following words and phrases shall mean:

1. **Luyag Ko Tan Yaman** – as the official song composed in Pangasinan language by Mr. Raul “Insiyong” Tamayo, and melody and musical arrangement by Mr. Deneo V. Tamayo.
2. **Pangasinan** – comprising of 44 municipalities including cities of Dagupan, Alaminos, San Carlos and Urdaneta.

**SECTION 3. OBJECTIVE.** The singing of the “Luyag Ko Tan Yaman” as the official Provincial Hymn of Pangasinan shall enkindle more the cultural enlightenment and social consciousness of the people of Pangasinan, especially the school children and the youth.

**SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION.** In view of the adoption thereof of the “Luyag Ko Tan Yaman” as the official Provincial Hymn of Pangasinan, it shall be played on and sang in public and official functions, specifically every Monday morning during the flag raising ceremonies.

At the first note of the Provincial Hymn, all persons shall execute a salute by placing their right palms over their left chests. Those in military, scouting, citizens military training and security guard uniforms shall give the salute prescribed by their regulations. The salute shall be completed upon the last note of the hymn.

**SECTION 5. COVERAGE.** All government offices, national or local and all schools, public and private, located in the Province including component cities, are required to sing the official Provincial Hymn of Pangasinan.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall be valid and effective immediately upon the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.
