RESOLUTION NO. 184-2022

DECLARING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 OF BURGOS, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P152,689,195.00 OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Burgos, Pangasinan submitted its Annual Budget for Calendar Year 2022 involving total appropriations of P152,689,195.00, which was enacted on December 6, 2021, 2021 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 6, Series of 2021;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted preliminary review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That the appropriations for the implementation of the Third Tranche compensation adjustment for all municipal officials & employees shall be subject to the provisions of Executive Order No. 76 of the Office of the President dated March 15, 2019 and specific guidelines to be issued by the Department of Budget and Management;

- 2. That the appropriation for Personnel Benefits shall only be disbursed upon issuance of guidelines granting the same, otherwise, the same shall be deemed bereft of legal basis;
- 3. That the items funded out of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Fund shall be in accordance with R.A No. 10121 June 1, 2021 and DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-1 dated August 11, 2021 and shall be consistent with Devolution Transition Plan of the Municipality;
- 4. That the deficiency in appropriation of 5% LDRRM Fund amounting to P1,087,480.25 shall be appropriated in the first Supplemental Budget of the municipality pursuant to Section 324 (d) of R. A. No. 7160;
- That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the provisions of R.A. No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;
- 6. That all programs, projects and activities shall be accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and the FY 2020 Annual Investment Program of the municipality formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 series of 2007 dated 08 March 2007;
- That the purchase of motor vehicle shall be in accordance with provisions of DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2021-04 dated January 18, 2021;
- 8. That the projects under the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for development projects (20% Development Fund) shall be subject to the provisions of DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1 dated February 22, 2017 re: Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the Twenty Percent (20%) of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects;
- 9. That the appropriation for devolved functions and services should be provided in FY 2022 pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order No. 138 dated June 1, 2021 and DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-1 dated August 11, 2021 and shall be consistent with the Devolution Transition Plan of the Municipality; and

10. That the grant of step increment to some employees shall be in accordance with CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 1, S-2012 dated September 3, 2012 and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 1, s-2016 dated January 27, 2016 and therefore the salary of Mr. Albert A. Cuaresma, Water Pump Operator shall be adjusted from SG-4/4 P138,072.00 per annum to SG-4/5 P139,128.00 per annum.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Donabel N. Fontelera and Margielou Orange D. Humilde-Verzosa and cosponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan, duly seconded, it was –

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Operative in its Entirety the Annual Budget for Calendar Year 2022 of Burgos, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Burgos, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
