PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 199-2021

INVITING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE AND PRIVATE VEHICLE CLUBS TO A QUESTION HOUR OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN DURING ITS FEBRUARY 15, 2021 REGULAR (PHYSICAL) SESSION TO APPRISE THE BODY ON THE MECHANICS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PRIVATE MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION CENTERS (PMVICs) IN THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, the Motor Vehicle Inspection System (MVIS) is a new program that would check the roadworthiness of the vehicle to be registered;

WHEREAS, as such, accredited Private Motor Vehicle Inspections Centers (PMVICs) are now allowed by the Land Transportation Office to operate in the Province;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan believes that the implementation of this scheme might be causing unnecessary uproar to particular sectors of the community especially car enthusiasts and motor vehicle owners;

WHEREAS, the inspection fees for motor vehicles set by PMVICs might be adding heavy load being experienced already by the people of Pangasinan on account of the public health crisis;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan would like to know also if the PMVICs are not in violation to the General Welfare Clause of RA 7160 and Section 19 of LTO Memorandum Circular No. 2018-2158 which provides that “the complaints and feedbacks of customers should be monitored and analyzed, and the contents of the LTO’s Quality Management Procedure Manual should be observed in handling client’s complaints related to the implementation of the motor vehicle inspection system;
