EXPLANATORY NOTE

Caloccan Dupo is an existing sitio of Caloccan Sur in the municipality of Binmaley.

It has at present a population of 1,033 as certified by the Local Government Officer of that municipality and therefore meets the requirements provided for under Section 83 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 337.

The COMELEC registrar also certified the existence of Four Hundred Twenty-Four (424) voters comprising one (1) precinct - Precinct No. 27.

The Municipal Treasurer also issued a certification that the proposed barangay has a good source of income to enable Caloocan Dupo to be a viable barangay from its fisheries and fishponds.

The petition of the barangay council of mother barangay Caloocan Sur in its Resolution No. 1, series of 1988, dated February 18, 1988, and the favorable indersement of the Sangguniang Bayan of Birmaley are hereto attached and made an integral parts hereof.

In view of the belief that the creation of a new barangay will greatly accelerate the progress and development of the proposed barangay and in the exercise of self-determination and pursuant to the law on Local Autonomy, the creation of Barangay Caloocan Dupo is strongly recommended for approval.

WHEREAS, the 1,033 residents of Sitic Caloccan Dupo of Caloccan Sur, Birmaley, Pangasiran, petitioned the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to create Barangay Caloccan Dupo;
