RESOLUTION NO. 20-2021

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 20-082 OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF SAN CARLOS, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “CHANGING THE TITLE FROM PROJECT TITLED: ASPHALT OVERLAY AT BRGY. ANTIPANGOL TO PROJECT TITLED: CONCRETING OF ROAD AT BRGY. ANTIPANGOL (PHASE II) AMOUNTING TO P1,500,000.00 AND CHANGING THE LOCATION FROM PROJECT TITLED: CONCRETING OF ROAD AT BRGY. TURAC (SITIO IGUIR) TO PROJECT TITLED: CONCRETING OF ROAD AT BRGY. TURAC (SITIO MALAY)”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of San Carlos, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 20-082 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the City Development Council – Executive Committee of San Carlos City, Pangasinan has proposed for the change in title and location of the aforementioned projects. This was endorsed by the Council thru CDC Resolution No. 18-20 (Series of 2020) dated November 3, 2020 to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for approval;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod approved said endorsement through Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution No. 20-082 dated November 9, 2020. The SP Resolution involves change in project title and location, but no change in the project’s investment requirement;

WHEREAS, said projects were covered in LGU’s Supplemental Investment Program No. 5, CY 2020 and funded under Supplemental Budget No. 04-20, FY 2020;
