RESOLUTION NO. 219-2021

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-159 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BINALONAN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "ADOPTING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BINALONAN FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2021"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Binalonan, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 2020-159 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the same is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of RA 7160. The Local Development Council of Binalonan, Pangasinan has formulated the municipality's Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2021 and endorsed through MDC Resolution No. 2, S-2020 dated September 25, 2020 to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval. This was subsequently approved by the Sangguniang Bayan through Resolution No. 2020-159 dated December 7, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Binalonan, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form categorized into general public, social, economic and other services sectors and covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operations of the different municipal offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS),



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Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the priority development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, c) Disaster Risk Reduction programs, projects and activities of the municipality. It also includes the following: 1) Gender and Development Plan, Peace and Order and Public Safety Plan, Local Climate Change Action Plan, Nutrition Plan, Tourism, Culture and Arts Plan, and 2) list of programs/projects/activities for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities;

WHEREAS, the AIP of Binalonan has a total investment requirement of P242,459,158.00. The amount of P240,502,152.00 is supported by CY 2021 Annual Budget of the municipality which was passed and approved by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2020-03 dated December 7, 2020 while the remaining amount of P1,957,006.00 will be sourced from the national and provincial government and Share from Tobacco Excise Tax;

WHEREAS, this is also in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160. The development fund amounting to P31,372,936.00 which is allocated for development projects is 20% of the municipality's IRA (P156,864,680.00) for CY 2021;

WHEREAS, the identified development programs/projects to be funded by the 20% of IRA are in conformity with Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular 1, dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects);

WHEREAS, the programs/projects/activities identified to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the municipality amounting to P9,507,499.00 is in conformity to Section 21 of RA 10121 and NDRMMC, DBM & DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 of the Department of Interior and Local Government (Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). Further, the LDRRM Plan of the municipality was reviewed and a certification was issued by the Office of the Civil Defense (OCD) to the municipality dated December 16, 2020;

WHEREAS, the LGU had also identified programs, projects and activities responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015;

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Plan of the municipality was already reviewed by the Department of the Interior and Local Government and found to be fully compliant in form and in contents with the provisions of DBM-PCW-DILG-NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2016-01: Amendments to JMC 2013-01 re: Guidelines on the Localization of Magna Carta of Women as per attached Certificate of Review and Endorsement of the DILG dated June 25, 2020;
