#### **RESOLUTION NO. 252-2021**

#### APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 20-108-A OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF STA. MARIA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM FOR THE YEAR 2021 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF STA. MARIA, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 20-108-A to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the Local Development Council of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan has formulated the municipality's Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2021, and endorsed through MDC Resolution No. 2020-4 dated October 12, 2020 to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval. This is in pursuance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form categorized into general public, social, economic and other services. It likewise covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operations of the different municipal offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the priority







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development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, and c) Disaster Risk Reduction Management Programs/Projects/Activities of the municipality. It further includes the following: 1) Gender and Development Plan, Local Climate Change Action Plan, Peace and Order Plan, Culture and Arts Plan, Local Population and Nutrition Action Plan and 2) list of programs/projects/activities for Senior Citizens and Persons; Local Council for the Protection of Children, and to Combat AIDS;

**WHEREAS,** the AIP of Sta. Maria has a total investment requirement amounting to P350,654,546.06. Of this, P126,454,546.06 will be funded from the CY 2021 Annual Budget of the municipality which was enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance Nos. 20-04-A and 20-05-A, both dated January 19, 2021. The remaining amount of P224,200,000.00 are development projects proposed to be funded from external fund sources;

WHEREAS, the development fund amounting to P24,000,000.00 which is allocated for development projects is twenty percent (20%) of the municipality's IRA (P116,711,730.00) for CY 2021. This is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, the identified development programs/projects to be funded by the 20% of IRA are based on the DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects);

WHEREAS, the programs, projects and activities identified to be funded by the 5% LDRRM Fund of the municipality amounting to P6,110,236.50 conforms with Section 21 of RA 10121 and NDRMMC, DBM & DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). Further, the LDRRM Plan was reviewed and a certification was issued by the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) to the LGU dated November 6, 2020;

WHEREAS, the LGU has also identified programs, projects and activities responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015;

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Plan of the municipality has been reviewed by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and found to be fully compliant in form and contents with the provisions of the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2016-01: Amendments to JMC 2013-01 re: Guidelines on the Localization of Magna Carta of Women as per attached Certificate of Review and Endorsement of the DILG dated March 22, 2019;







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**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Sta. Maria;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Salvador S. Perez, Jr. and Noel C. Bince and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jeanne Jinky C. Zaplan, duly seconded, it was –

**RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 20-108-A of the Sangguniang Bayan of **Sta. Maria**, Pangasinan, entitled "Approving the Annual Investment Program for the year 2021 of the Municipality of Sta. Maria, Pangasinan";
