RESOLUTION NO. 303-2022

DECLARING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P936,593,136.00, OPERATIVE IN PART

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Alaminos, Pangasinan submitted its Annual Budget for Calendar Year 2022 involving total appropriations of P936,593,136.00, which was enacted on December 13, 2021 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2, Series of 2021;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted preliminary review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That the full implementation of the Third Tranche compensation adjustment for municipal officials and employees shall be subject to the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 143 dated January 3, 2022 of the Department of Budget and Management;



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2. That the projects under the 20% of the Annual National Tax Allotment (NTA) for development projects (20% Development Fund) shall be subject to the provisions of DBM-DOF-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 Re: Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the Twenty Percent (20%) of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for the Development Projects;
3. That the items funded out of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Fund shall be in accordance with R.A No. 10121 known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Act of 2010 and its IRR, and the Department of Budget and Management-National Disaster Risk reduction and Management Council-Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 re: Allocation & Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Fund (LDRRMF);
4. That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provision of R.A No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;
5. That the Gratuity Pay to Contract of Service and Job Order Workers in the city government shall be implemented upon issuance of a circular granting the same;
6. That all appropriations for Public Affairs Fund under the Special Purpose Appropriation be spent solely for public purposes and no amount shall be applied for religious or private purpose pursuant to Section 305 (b) of R.A. 7160 & shall be broken down into appropriate objects of expenditures, as may be applicable in accordance with the New Government Accounting System (NGAS);
7. That the purchase of motor vehicle shall be in accordance with provisions of DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2021-04 dated January 18, 2021;
8. That the appropriations for devolved functions and services shall be in accordance with the provisions of Executive Order No. 138 dated June 1, 2021 and DILG - DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-1 dated August 11, 2021, and shall be consistent with the Devolution Transition Plan of the municipality;
9. That the appropriation for Other Personnel Benefits shall be disbursed upon issuance of guidelines granting the same, otherwise, the same shall be deemed bereft of legal basis; and
