**RESOLUTION NO. 313-2021**

**APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-183 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SUAL, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) CY 2021 OF SUAL, PANGASINAN AMOUNTING TO NINE HUNDRED EIGHT MILLION PESOS (P908,000,000.00)”**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sual, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 2020-183 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the same is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of RA 7160. The Local Development Council of Sual, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2021. This was endorsed by the Local Development Council to the Sangguniang Bayan on September 10, 2020 through MDC Resolution No. 13, S-2020;

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Sual, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operations of the different municipal offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the



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priority development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, c) Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan d) Peace and Order Plan, e) Gender and Development Plan, f) Nutrition Action Plan, and g) list of programs, projects and activities for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities, and PPAs to combat AIDS and to address the problem on illegal drugs;

**WHEREAS**, funding support for the implementation of said AIP is embodied in their 2021 proposed Annual Budget in the amount of P398,000,000.00, which was approved and enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan on December 14, 2020 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 01;

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Investment Program also includes proposed programs, projects and activities proposed for funding by National Government Agencies and other fund sources;

**WHEREAS**, this AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGU's IRA (P132,900,474.00), which is equivalent to P26,580,094.80 is allocated for development projects. These development programs/projects conform to the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1, dated November 4, 2020 (*Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects*);

**WHEREAS**, the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% LDRRM Fund (P19,900,000.00), is in conformity to Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs, projects and activities to be funded by 70% of the 5% LDRRM Fund in the amount of P13,930,000.00 were based on NDRMMC-DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (*Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund*). Further, the DRRM Plan of the municipality shall be submitted to the Office of the Civil Defense for review as per Local Budget Memorandum No. 77, dated May 15, 2018;

**WHEREAS**, the LGU of Sual had also identified programs, projects and activities responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015;
