## **PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 315-2020**

INVITING THE MUNICIPAL MAYORS OF LINGAYEN AND BINMALEY, THE GENERAL SERVICES OFFICE, PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL AND BARANGAY CAPTAINS OF LIBSONG WEST AND EAST, MANIBOC AND PANGAPISAN NORTH, ALL OF LINGAYEN, AND BARANGAY CAPTAINS OF BAYBAY LOPEZ, SAN ISIDRO NORTE AND BUENLAG, ALL OF BINMALEY, TO A QUESTION HOUR OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN DURING ITS MARCH 23, 2020 REGULAR SESSION TO UPDATE THE BODY ON THE STATUS OF LINGAYEN BAYWALK, LINGAYEN LIMAHONG TOURISM CENTER AND LINGAYEN ECO-TOURISM PARK AND OTHER AREAS OF CONCERN SUCH AS THE MAINTENANCE OF CLEANLINESS, ORDERLINESS AND SAFETY ALONG THE AREAS

WHEREAS, infrastructures are vital components to the development of a locality;

WHEREAS, the Lingayen Baywalk, Lingayen Limahong Tourism Center and Lingayen Eco-Tourism Park are tourist sites and civic activity areas located at the beachfront where people from all walks of life congregate;

WHEREAS, the infrastructure projects are important to the socio-economic development of the Municipality of Lingayen and the neighboring areas but it is also essential to maintain the cleanliness, orderliness and safety along the areas;

**WHEREAS,** it is also the desire of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to be updated on the status of these infrastructure projects;

**WHEREAS,** likewise, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan would like to inquire anew into the problems besetting the areas, in aid of legislation, so that remedial measures can be adopted by the concerned authorities;

**WHEREAS**, there should be concerted efforts between the Municipalities of Lingayen and Binmaley and the Provincial Government of Pangasinan to maintain the cleanliness, orderliness and safety along said area;

**WHEREFORE,** in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Member Nestor D. Reyes, duly seconded, it was –

**RESOLVED,** by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled to invite, as they are hereby invited, the Municipal Mayors of Lingayen and Binmaley, the General Services Office, Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and Barangay Captains of Libsong West and East, Maniboc and Pangapisan North, all of Lingayen, and Barangay Captains of Baybay Lopez, San Isidro Norte and Buenlag, all of Binmaley, to a Question Hour of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan during its March 23, 2020 Regular Session to update the Body on the status of Lingayen Baywalk, Lingayen Limahong Tourism Center and Lingayen Eco-Tourism Park and other areas of concern such as the maintenance of cleanliness, orderliness and safety along the areas;
