RESOLUTION NO. 375-2020

DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF AGNO, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF LIBRARIAN I, ITEM NO. 09-01-53 WITH SALARY GRADE ELEVEN (11) AND CREATING THE POSITION OF BUDGET OFFICER I WITH SALARY GRADE ELEVEN (11) IN THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF AGNO, PANGASINAN" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Agno, Pangasinan submitted its Municipal Ordinance No. 2020-01 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 76 and Section 447 (a) (1) (viii) of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, however, the position of Budget Officer I, Salary Grade 11, should be changed to Administrative Officer II, Salary Grade 11, to conform with the provisions of Budget Circular No. 2004-3 dated March 6, 2004 entitled "Conversion of Positions Performing Staff/Non-Technical Functions";
