RESOLUTION NO. 379-2020

DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 1, S-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MABINI, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ON COLLECTION OF CORRESPONDING BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE IN THE APPLICATION FOR ANY BUSINESS RELATED TRANSACTION" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mabini, Pangasinan submitted its Municipal Ordinance No. 1, S-2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said municipal ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Sections 447 (3) (i) of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, however, there is a need for barangay/s to pass an ordinance relative to Barangay Clearance Fees or Business Permit and Location Clearance for Building Permit and to pass a barangay resolution authorizing the Municipal Treasurer to collect the aforementioned fees before the subject municipal ordinance can be effected;

WHEREAS, subject ordinance shall take effect after the Sanggunian has complied with the requirements set forth in Sections 187 and 188 of RA 7160;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Donabel N. Fontelera and Margielou Orange D. Humilde-Verzosa and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jose G. Peralta, Jr., duly seconded, it was –
