PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 388-2022

URGING THE INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES (IATF) FOR THE RETENTION OF THE ALERT LEVEL 1 STATUS IN THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, the Province of Pangasinan is one of the provinces in the country which was placed under Alert Level 1 from March 1-15, 2022;

WHEREAS, after March 15, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) will make its decision on the new alert level classifications in the country based on the latest COVID-19 data;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan fully supports the IATF in its objectives of being careful in further easing the restrictions in the country despite the continued drop in COVID -19 infections;

WHEREAS, according to the Secretary of Health, Honorable Francisco T.

Duque III, the IATF will study the possible downscaling of COVID-19 alert level classification in several parts of the country to Alert Level 0;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan expresses concern whether Pangasinan is now ready for a lesser stringent alert level and more relaxed restrictions which may result to a superspreader situation especially with the start of the 2022 local election campaign period on March 25;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan deemed it necessary that the status of the economy and health care which were realized in the Province of Pangasinan for the last two (2) weeks under Alert Level 1 must be maintained and improved;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan urges the IATF that the present alert level status in Pangasinan should remain for now because of a few COVID-19 cases still being recorded in the Province;

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled to urge, as it is hereby urged, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) for the retention of the Alert Level 1 Status in the Province of Pangasinan;
