APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 164, S-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM 2021 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Basista, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 164, Series of 2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of RA 7160. The Local Development Council of Basista, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2021. This was endorsed by the Local Development Council to the Sangguniang Bayan on September 8, 2020 through MDC Resolution No. 8, S-2020;

WHEREAS, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Basista, Pangasinan was formulated following the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operations of the different city offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the priority

development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, c) Disaster Risk Reduction programs, projects and activities, d) Local Climate Change Action Plan, e) Peace and Order Plan, f) Gender and Development Plan, g) Annual Procurement Plan, h) Annual Cultural Development Plan, i) Nutrition Action Plan, and j) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities, and PPAs to combat AIDS and PPAs to address the problems of illegal drugs;

WHEREAS, the proposed AIP of Basista for CY 2021 has an investment requirement of P306,617,206.42. Funding support for the implementation of said AIP is embodied in their 2021 proposed Annual Budget in the amount of P120,157,206.42, which was passed and approved by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 5, S-2020 dated October 19, 2020. The remaining amount of P186,460,000.00 is proposed for funding from national government agencies and other fund sources:

WHEREAS, said AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGU's IRA (P109,558,591.00), which is equivalent to P21,911,718.20 is allocated for development projects. These development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% development fund were based on the DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1, dated February 22, 2017 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects";

WHEREAS, the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% LDRRM Fund (P5,752,929.56), is in conformity to Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs, projects and activities to be funded by 70% of the 5% LDRRM Fund in the amount of P4,027,050.69 were based on NDRMMC, DBM & DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). The LDRRM Plan was reviewed and evaluated by the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Regional Office 1 Regional Assessment Team based on OCD Certification dated September 22, 2020;

WHEREAS, the LGU of Basista had also identified programs, projects and activities responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015;

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Programs, Projects and Activities (GAD-PPAs) attached were reviewed by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Provincial Office, and were found to be fully compliant in form and in contents with the provisions of the DBM, PCW, DILG & NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2016-01: Amendments to JMC 2013-01 re: Guidelines on the Localization of Magna Carta of Women;
