## **PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 504-2019**

**EXPRESSING SUPPORT TO MS. CHERRY ANN P. MEJIA OF LABRADOR AND SAN JACINTO, PANGASINAN FOR BEING ONE OF THE REPRESENTATIVES IN THE 2019 SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES TO BE HOSTED BY THE PHILIPPINES**

**WHEREAS**, the 2019 Southeast Asian Games, officially known as the 30<sup>th</sup> Southeast Asian Games, is a biennial multi-sport event which aims to help promote cooperation, understanding and relations among other countries in the region with this year's motto dubbed as "We Win As One";

**WHEREAS**, the 30<sup>th</sup> edition of the Southeast Asian Games will be hosted by the Philippines in various cities, specifically in Manila, Clark and Subic, from November 30 to December 11, 2019;

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Cherry Ann P. Mejia, a native of Labrador and San Jacinto, Pangasinan, will represent the Philippines in the Chess Sport competition in the 30<sup>th</sup> Southeast Asian Games which will be participated in by 9,840 athletes from 11 participating countries of Southeast Asia;

Mejia has already made her mark in various national and international chess tournaments in the past years by bringing home gold, bronze and silver medals wherein she has garnered her title as Woman FIDE Master last 2009 and up to the present, she is still an Active Woman Fide Chess Master of the National Chess Federation of the Philippines;
