#### **RESOLUTION NO. 595-2020**

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2020 OF MABINI, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P26,651,029.68 OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mabini, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 1 for Calendar Year 2020 involving total appropriations of **P26,651,029.68** which was approved on April 6, 2020 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 1, S-2020;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted preliminary review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. The full implementation of the First Tranche Salary Adjustment to all municipal officials and employees shall be subject to the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 121 of the Department of Budget and Management dated January 24, 2020 Re: Implementation of the First Tranche of the Modified Salary Schedule for Local Government Personnel Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11466;

- The grant of step increment to some municipal officials and employees shall be in accordance with CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 01, S-2012 dated September 3, 2012 and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 01, S-2016 dated January 27, 2016;
- 3. The grant of Hazard Pay to government personnel who physically report for work during the period of implementation of an Enhanced Community Quarantine relative to the COVID-19 Outbreak shall be in accordance with the provisions of Administrative Order No. 26 by the President of the Philippines dated March 23, 2020 and Budget Circular No. 2020-1 dated March 24, 2020.
- 4. The items funded out of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund shall be in accordance with RA No. 10121 known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 and its IRR and the DBM-NDRRM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 re: Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) and that 30% shall be set aside as Quick Response Fund;
- 5. The projects under the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for development projects (20% Development Fund) shall be subject to the provisions of DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1 dated February 22, 2017, Re: Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of Twenty Percent (20%) of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects:
- 6. The appropriation for the payment of Terminal Leave Benefits (TLB) of retired LGU personnel shall be subject to the provisions of DBM Budget Circular No. 2016-2 dated March 29, 2016 re: Computation and Funding of Terminal Leave Benefits and Monetization of Leave Credits, which provides for the new constant factor stated under Item 3.1 thereof;
- 7. All procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of RA No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations; *and*
- All programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and FY 2020 Annual/Supplemental Investment Program of the municipality formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, S-2007 dated 08 March 2007.

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;
