PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 65-2021

AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR, AMADO I. ESPINO III, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF BALUNGAO FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CURING BARN TO HELP TOBACCO GROWERS IN THE PROVINCE

WHEREAS, one major development thrust of the Provincial Government is to increase agricultural productivity and to bring essential services and assistance at the grass root level to effect positive socio-economic change in the lives of farmers and fisherfolk and the whole agricultural sector of the Province;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Balungao is one of the main tobacco producers in the Province;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government in support to tobacco producers, through its Provincial Agriculture Office, is implementing the construction of a tobacco curing barn towards better profitability of tobacco growers;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Balungao submitted a resolution request to the Provincial Government for the immediate construction of a tobacco curing barn to improve the quality of tobacco produce of their farmers for higher buying price thereby increasing their profitability;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Balungao voluntarily allows the use of an identified lot for the construction of a curing barn for the benefit of their tobacco producers;

WHEREAS, in regard to the above purpose, a Memorandum of Agreement shall be entered into and signed between the Province of Pangasinan, represented by Governor Amado I. Espino III and the Municipality of Balungao, represented by Mayor Maria Theresa R. Peralta;
