RESOLUTION NO. 668-2019

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 2 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019 OF BALUNGAO, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P11,353,974.53 OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Balungao, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 2 for Calendar Year 2019 involving total appropriations of **P11,353,974.53** which was approved on October 9, 2019 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2019-02;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted preliminary review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. The funding sources for the subject Supplemental Budget were determined in accordance with Section 321 of RA 7160 and Article 417 (a) of its IRR, as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;



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2. The appropriation for salaries of the newly-created positions implementing the Fourth Tranche Compensation Adjustment for Local Government Personnel shall be subject to the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 118 of the Department of Budget and Management dated January 15, 2019;
3. The salary grade of Accountant II under the Office of the Municipal Accountant shall be adjusted to Salary Grade 16 to conform with the Local Budget Circular No. 2009-92 of the Department of Budget and Management dated September 3, 2009. Said position was included in the list of reallocated classes of positions in Annex "B" of said Circular;
4. The utilization of all appropriations for Capital Outlay, shall, as may be applicable, be subject to the authorization of the Sanggunian on the list of projects to be implemented as ruled by the Supreme Court in the case of Hon. Gabriel Luis Quisumbing, et. al. versus Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia, et. al., G.R. No. 175527, December 8, 2008;
5. The projects funded under the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for development projects (20% Development Fund) shall be subject to the provisions of DILG and DBM JMC No. 2017-1 dated February 22, 2017 re "Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the twenty percent (20%) of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects" and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2010-138 dated December 2, 2010, entitled "Use of the 20% Component of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment Shares";
and
6. The items funded out of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund shall be in accordance with RA No. 10121 known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 and its IRR and the DBM-NDRRM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 re: Allocation and Utilization of the Local Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF).

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the above-findings shall be complied with by the municipality;



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NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Noel C. Bince and Salvador S. Perez, Jr. and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jose G. Peralta, Jr., duly seconded, it was –

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare **OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY the Supplemental Budget No. 2 for Calendar Year 2019 of Balungao, Pangasinan** as of the date fixed therein for its effectivity; provided, that the disbursement of appropriations as approved shall be subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations, and compliance with other pertinent laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Balungao;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Balungao, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
